Our eyes keep being opened by so many opportunities to teach our students Christian based curriculum. Government funds are not able to be used for any curriculum that has a Christian base. Therefore, the school needs to find ways to fund these programs. LEAP is always open to hear what opportunities we can help with.

In our March meeting, LEAP approved using LEAP funds to purchase a Biblically Social Emotional Learning (SEL) curriculum for K-8, Friendzy. The Friendzy Program teaches the five-core competencies of SEL through the lens of Scripture. These competencies include self-awareness, self-management, responsible decision making, social awareness and relationship skills.

Teaching friendship skills supports students in managing their emotions, improving ability to set and achieve positive goals, feeling and showing empathy for others, maintaining positive relationships, and making responsible decisions.
