Priority Enrollment '24-'25- Secure your spot!



It is hard to believe that we are halfway through the 2023-24 school year and already at that time to be thinking about the 2024-25 school year! Current students that will be returning have a 2 week "**Priority**" registration window for re-enrollment that is currently underway! This allows for returning families to get first priority for the 2024-25 school year. The "**Priority**" window for returning students **began 1/11/2024** @ 9:00am and runs through 1/25/2024 @ 4:00pm. After the

priority enrollment window closes, enrollment will be on a first come, first serve basis and will be based on the time-stamp of the completed online enrollment with paid enrollment fees. We recommend you take advantage of the 2 week priority enrollment to secure your child's spot for 2024-2025.

Mission of the Quarter-Personal Needs Pantry


